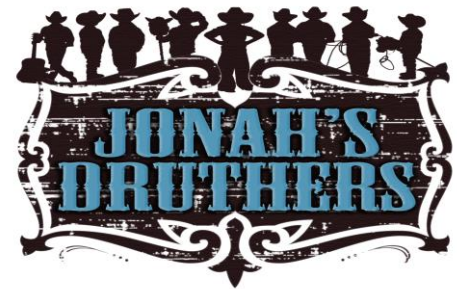


No School – May 22
