Looking Back...

Language Arts– We enjoyed reading some favourite Froggy books and seeing how literary characters are similar to all of us. That theme continued with Canadian author Paulette Bourgeois and her turtle creation, Franklin.

Math– The Grade Ones did a great job exploring the concept of Time before moving on to counting by 2s, 5s, and 10s and the different groupings found in number charts. The Grade Twos did a great job with their Money unit and three dimensional geometry.

Materials and Structures – We began January with a unit called Structures. We examined how different structures are constructed and the purpose of various structures and the materials used to build them. Everyone did an incredible job building their own structures!

Looking Ahead...

Language Arts – We begin the month of February with the continuation of our Franklin unit. We will then begin a unit on Poetry. We will learn a lot about different types of poetry and will work together to create our own poems. Watch for our Poetry Anthology at the end of the month.

Math – The Grade One's will begin their study on Fractions and end the unit with a sweet lesson on chocolate math. They then begin a unit on linear measurement and end the month with a look at geometric solids. The Grade Two's will take a look at patterning before moving on to an extensive unit on different types of graphs and how to construct them. They end the month with a study of capacity.

Social Studies – Towards the end of the month we will begin a study of Life in the Arctic. We will look at traditional life in the North and how it is changing with modern advancements. We will also learn about the wildlife found in the coldest region of Canada.

Science – We will continue our study of Energy in our Lives and learn about the different types of energy and the sources that provide them. We will also take a look at the seasonal changes that occur due to the differences in energy levels that we receive from our Sun.
